

# Lartington Parish Council

## Minutes of Meeting held on March 13th 2018

### Present

### 01. Recording of the meeting

The Chair opened the meeting by enquiring whether anyone present intended to make a recording of the meeting. No one had such an intention.

### 02. Speed Issues in Lartington

Cllr. Bell was welcomed to the meeting. He outlined exchanges that had taken place between himself and DCC Highways department. A recent survey demonstrated that there really was a problem, with 16% of vehicles travelling in excess of 36mph whilst DCC Officers accepted that the rota for the deployment of speedvisors could be changed to include Lartington if there was a political will to do so. DCC Highways proposed, therefore, to conduct another speed monitoring exercise in the near future and if the results were similar to those previously recorded then Lartington would be included in the programme.

Cllr. Bell was thanked for his efforts on our behalf and it was agreed that we would remain in contact on this issue.

### 03. Apologies

The clerk reported that Mr. Crawford had submitted apologies due to an important personal commitment. It was unanimously resolved that these be accepted and approved.

### 04. Disclosures of Interest

### 05. Minutes

The minutes of the meeting held on January 9th were read and signed by the Chairman as a true record of the proceedings of that meeting.

### 06. Matters Arising

- a. Flooding on Green Lane - the Clerk reported that work was supposed to begin on March 12th but appeared not to have done so, probably due to recent poor weather. He agreed to contact Brian Featherstone to check on this.
- b. Prescription delivery services - the Clerk reported that he had completed the recent survey into pharmaceutical services, in which he expressed our concerns over this matter. Mrs Parsons Munn reported that she understood that a postal delivery service was being introduced by the NHS and agreed to investigate this further.
- c. Drainage - the Clerk stated that he had reported this matter to DCC Highways and that, following an intervention from Mrs Parsons Munn, problems with drainage in the area of the junction with Lartington green Lane now appear to have been resolved.
- d. Aqueduct - this continues to cause corner. The clerk reported that he had had no further correspondence from Bryan Harris and would raise the matter once again.



#### **14. Planning Matters**

**Scur Beck Fish Pass** - this was briefly discussed. There had been initial concerns that this may cause some disruption or diversion to the footpath but it was agreed that this did not appear to be the case and members were happy to support the proposal.
